

KEY VERSES IN I CORINTHIANS SHARED BY PASTOR KEITH

I CORINTHIANS

1:18, 23, 31

For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. ...but we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness... ...so that, just as it is written, "Let him who boasts, boast in the Lord."

2:2, 10, 14

For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God. But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

3:1-3, 8, 11-14, 16

And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to infants in Christ. I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it. Indeed, even now you are not yet able, for you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking like mere men? Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but each will receive his own reward according to his own labor. For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work. If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward.

Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

4:2, 10

In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy. We are fools for Christ's sake, but you are prudent in Christ; we are weak, but you are strong; you are distinguished, but we are without honor.

5:6

Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough?

6:3, 11-12, 19-20

Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more matters of this life? Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God. All things are lawful for me, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be mastered by anything. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

7:19

Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but what matters is the keeping of the commandments of God.

8:8-9

But food will not commend us to God; we are neither the worse if we do not eat, nor the better if we do eat. But take care that this liberty of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak.

9:22-24, 26-27

To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak; I have become all things to all men, so that I may by all means save some. I do all things for the sake of the gospel, so that I may become a fellow partaker of it. Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win. Therefore I run in such a way, as not without aim; I box in such a way, as not beating the air; but I discipline my body and make it my slave, so that, after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified.

10:23, 31

All things are lawful, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful, but not all things edify. Whether, then, you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

11:1, 28

Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ. But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

12:7, 13, 26

But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.

13:4-8, 13

Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered, does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
